## **Minutes of a Meeting of Snelson Parish held in Snelson Chapel Vestry on Tuesday 10<sup>th</sup> March 2015 at 7.45pm**

**15.01 Apologies** – Cllr Firth

**15.02 Declarations of Interest** – None

**15.03 Public Question time** – None

**15.04 Approve Minutes.** The minutes of the last meeting were agreed and signed off.

### **15.05 Matters arising from the minutes**

Cllr Hopkinson updated the meeting on his CCTV enquiries. There are issues with finding suitable sites in a rural area as you cannot train the cameras on the roads. The only way forward would be to erect them on private dwellings and this cannot be done with public funds. There is also a huge difference in types of camera. A number plate recognition camera would be in the region of £2000. Then an electricity supply would be needed both to the camera and to the recording device.

The Clerk had contacted a contractor regarding the gritting. However after sending the maps of the area and detailing the roads to be gritted, she has heard nothing back. She will contact him again and see if something can be put in place for next winter.

### **15.06 Broadband**

Information is on the website. The emphasis is on people to change over to fibre broadband it won't happen automatically.

### **15.07 Common**

The Clerk has yet to hear from Mr Curtis, will continue to follow up.

### **15.08 Highways**

Cllr Winrow updated the meeting. Highways have done a speed survey on Pepper Street and found that the average speed was 45mph. However the survey was done when weather conditions were bad and so was not necessarily indicative of normal traffic speed.

Cllr Walton has asked Dave Thomason from Highways to look at signage for small local roads that are unsuitable for HGV wagons.

Cllr Hopkinson said that although an inconvenience there had been no major incidents caused by the HGVs and they often use the smaller roads as they have to access farms located on those roads. Signage was not going to stop these vehicles.

Cllr Stanier said that the repairs made to the junction of Mill lane and Common lane were inadequate and done in such an unsuitable way that as soon as they were repaired they were breaking up again. Cllr Walton to follow this up.

### **15.09 Finance**
