Minutes of Snelson Annual Parish Council meeting held in Snelson Chapel Vestry on Tuesday 9th May 2016 at 7.45pm.

Present - Cllr Gordon Phillips, Cllr Janet Winrow, Cllr John Firth, Cllr Hazel Ardern, Cllr Dave Clarke, Cllr George Walton (Cheshire East Borough Council) and the Clerk.

17.19 To Elect a Chairperson - Janet Winrow was proposed by John Firth and Seconded by Les Stanier. There were no other nominations and Cllr Winrow was duly elected.

17.20 To Elect a Vice Chairperson – John Firth was proposed by Janet Winrow and seconded by Les Stanier. There were no other nominations and Cllr Firth was duly elected.

17.21 To fill vacancies on the Parish council – There are no current voting vacancies; The Parish Council is represented on Over Peover Educational Foundation by Cllr Stanier.

17.22 Apologies – none.

17.23 Declarations of Interest – None

17.24 Parishioners Questions – None

17.25 Approve Minutes. The minutes of the last meeting were agreed and signed off.

17.26 Matters arising from the minutes – The Pension staging date are end of June. Clerk to make the declarations.

17.27 Finance The receipts and Payments report was presented to the meeting; payments were agreed and signed off. The bank reconciliation was accepted and agreed by the meeting.

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The annual statement of governance and annual return figures were agreed by the meeting.

A new bank mandate was signed. Cllr Winrow to take it in to a branch.

The meeting opted to sign up for a 5 year insurance deal.

Membership of CCA not necessary unless the Parish Council were interested in developing a neighbourhood plan. Cllr Winrow is to look into this.

17.28 Highways – the pilot 40mph scheme has been shelved due to a lack of evidence from traffic monitoring. The Speed Management strategy has been produced and should be used as a guide.

The Slow road markings on Pepper Street have not been reinstated. Cllr Firth is to bring it up with Simon Wallace on his visit with him on Thursday.

During this meeting they will also discuss the issues with the bell curbs and the lack of a turning circle. This was thought to have been thought about during the planning, however this has not been done and it needs rectifying.

Also under discussion is the HGV preferred route. However until the issues of the turning circle are resolved, there is little that can be done regarding this. Clerk is to provide Cllr Firth with a Map of the roads in question before the meeting on Thursday.

Cllr Firth also following up on the reinstatement of verges on Pepper Street and Mill Lane. The Common Lane Sign is to be added to the Cheshire East review of highway metal work.

17.29 Common– There has been a gate reinstalled on the common on the end owned by Silcock estate and there seems to be an intention to shoot in there in the fullness of time. The Clerk is to investigate this and contact the agent.

17.30 Planning – the application for Pepper Trees was reviewed by the council and they and no comment or objection to make.

17.31 Correspondence – a list was circulated to the meeting.
